# MARKET INSIGHTS

The textile and ready-to-wear sectors continue to be a cornerstone of the Tunisian economy, supported by a diversified and integrated value chain that includes spinning, weaving, finishing, hosiery, garment production, and downstream industries such as accessories and textile components. These capabilities, coupled with competitive advantages like skilled labor, strategic location, and preferential access to European markets, make Tunisia a highly attractive destination for foreign direct investment in textiles and apparel.

## Industry Structure & Economic Role

- The textile and apparel industry accounts for approximately 18% of Tunisia's industrial exports and employs around 160,000 people, underscoring its socio-economic importance.
- Within the broader manufacturing sector, textile, clothing, and leather represent around 26.6%, making it one of the largest segments of the Tunisian industrial base.

## Recent Export Performance

- In 2023, Tunisia's textile and clothing exports reached an estimated 8.18 billion TND (€2.36 billion), maintaining a strong export trajectory and continuing to reinforce Tunisia's role in global trade.
- The sector sustained positive momentum into 2025, with exports rising by 2.6% in the first five months, totaling nearly 3.94 billion Tunisian dinars (approx. €1.18 billion), reflecting resilience despite global market pressures.





# MARKET INSIGHTS

## European Market Dynamics

Tunisia remains a key supplier to the European Union:

- In 2024, approximately 9.7 million pieces of professional clothing were exported to EU markets, valued at about €317.7 million, with Tunisian workwear that commands one of the highest average unit prices within the EU.
- Tunisia has also strengthened its position in denim and workwear categories and ranks among the top suppliers to the EU and capturing notable market shares in specific segments.

## Strategic Advantages & Emerging Trends

- The sector's export orientation remains strong, with most of the production destined for European markets, particularly France, Italy, Germany, and other nearby countries, which leverages geographical proximity and trade linkages.
- Competitive labor costs, ongoing industrial reforms, and investment incentives continue to attract new foreign investments, including plans by international apparel brands to establish manufacturing operations in Tunisia.
- Despite global challenges such as rising input costs and shifting demand patterns, Tunisia's textile sector continues to adapt and targets advanced segments and reinforces export performance.
